COLLEGE OF EDUCATION ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE

The College of Education is led by the Dean, who reports to the University Provost (Office of Academic Affairs). Each program has a Director, who reports to the Associate Dean. The Directors are in charge of their program at both the graduate and undergraduate levels (if applicable). Faculty members report to the Director(s) of the licensure area(s) in which they teach. Administrators in the College of Education includes three Administrative Assistants, an Associate Dean (also serves as the Title II Coordinator), Director of the EDD Program, Director of Initial Programs, Director of the Teacher Leader Program, Director of the Principal Preparation Program, Director of the School Guidance Counselor Program, Director of Director of Field Experiences and Clinical Practice, Director of the Alternative Certification Program and Certification Officer.
