COLLEGE OF EDUCATION CURRICULUM COMMITTEE

The College of Education Curriculum Committee is composed of representatives from various programs offered in the College. These members elect a chair who, in turn.

The role of a college curriculum committee is to make recommendations to the dean following a presentation to the College of Education faculty body. The Dean has the responsibility of approving or disapproving recommendations forwarded by the College Curriculum Committee.

When the Dean makes the decision not to approve a recommendation from the College Curriculum Committee, the dean has an obligation to advise the College Committee and the College faculty regarding the rationale for the decision. This can be accomplished by meeting with the Committee and chair.

When the Dean approves a recommendation from the College Curriculum Committee, it is the responsibility of the College of Education Curriculum Committee, with support from the Dean, to forward the appropriate materials to the University Curriculum Committee through the Office Academic Affairs within a reasonable period of time.
